The Invitation: Waterhen Lake First Nation (WLFN) is providing the following information for the members of Waterhen Lake First Nation and interested friends of Waterhen Lake to consider submitting a Board Member Application for the new Waterhen Developments Limited.

The Development Corporation: The Waterhen Developments LP (WDLP) is a new limited partnership entity owned by the Waterhen Lake First Nation overseeing a group of companies involved in forestry, convenience, tourism, and other ventures from time to time.

The Board: The initial board composition consists of two (2) appointments from the WLFN, two (2) voting representatives from WLFN Leadership being the Chief and a Council representative or other designate(s) on behalf of Chief & Council (C & C), and one (1) independent director, for a total of five (5) voting member board positions. Each board member serves for a three and/or two-year staggered term. The board can have up to one (1) additional appointment from the WLFN and one (1) additional independent director as noted in the Waterhen Developments LP Business Charter adopted by the Waterhen Lake First Nation. During the process a nominations committee will accept applications on behalf of the Waterhen Lake First Nation up until March 22nd, 2019. The newly established Waterhen Developments Limited board will be appointed by the WLFN Chief & Council. The following five (5) initial positions will be duly appointed:

- 1. Chief & Council Representative Waterhen Lake First Nation C & C appointee (3-year term)
- 2. Chief & Council Representative Waterhen Lake First Nation C & C appointee (2-year term)
- 3. Board Member- Waterhen Lake First Nation appointee (3-year term)
- 4. Board Member Waterhen Lake First Nation appointee (2-year term)
- 5. Independent Director At Large (3-year term)

The Chair: The Board chair is selected by the board directors at a duly convened meeting of the board and shall sit for the duration of the initial three (3) year term appointment and may be eligible for re-appointment.

Board Terms: Board directors are eligible for re-appointment for up to two (2) full three (3) terms for a maximum of six (6) years continual service.

- You are bondable, and have not been convicted of an indictable offense for which you have not received a pardon in the last 5 years.

- You are familiar with the planning processes of land management and commercial operations, and/or industry operations of forestry, mining, oil and gas, manufacturing, processing, tourism, business, and commercial developments
