National Marriage Week USA

National Marriage Week began on February 7 and will appropriately end on Valentine's Day February 14. Last week we had a Holy Hour for marriage and families. Denny and Rachel Rall gave a witness on their enduring marriage at the Holy Hour. They will celebrate 60 years of marriage in June. They mentioned how important their Catholic faith was to keep their marriage strong, but that they don't always see things the same way. Still their love is very deep.

Marriage is not a nirvana of love in which nothing every goes wrong. It takes hard work, discipline, sacrifice, understanding, patience, compassion, listening skills, empathy, flexibility, wisdom, hope, prayer, etc. etc. But the most important part of keeping a marriage strong is to keep God at the center of the marriage. It is not an accident that people with a strong faith tend to have the longest marriages.

If you ask me the question- "How many couples have you married?" – I would reply- "Zero!" At least in the technical sense. When a priest or deacon presides at a wedding, they are witnessing at the Marriage Rite, but not "marrying" the couple. It is the consent of the couple- Their "I do" -that marries each other. So, to all the married couples in the parishes- If someone asks you- "Who married you?"- You can respond by saying- "Actually we married each other!"

This year my parents will be celebrating their 55th Wedding Anniversary! They needed the qualities I mentioned above to raise 7 children. I was the third of seven. They also needed their Catholic faith to help each other grow in their marriage and to help all their kids to grow up to be good people- not perfect-but good. Sunday was understood in our family to be 'attend Mass' day often followed by going to Bonanza for lunch. Attending Mass every Sunday is one of the most important habits a parent can instill in their children. It certainly helped me to discern the priesthood.

Marriage is the bedrock of our society. The happier marriages there are then the better society becomes. I believe the breakdown in our society and culture is because we do not have the typical 'nuclear family' (mother and father stay married their whole lives and raise good children) that we used to have. Divorce is sky high and not all children have a mother and father to guide them.

To all the married couples in our parishes, please check out the flier in this bulletin to reflect on how strong your marriage is and to consider things that could make it even stronger. Let me end with a quote from the "Wedding Song"- to inspire all you married couples "For the union of your spirits here has caused Him to remain. For whenever two or more of you are gathered in His name, there is Love."

Mass Cancellation During Inclement Weather The following policies are in effect for Sacred Heart when inclement weather threatens:

- On mornings when there is a school Mass, if there is a
 2 hour delay the Mass will be at 1:30 p.m. IF school is cancelled, the Mass is CANCELLED.
- If school is cancelled on a day when Mass is in the **evening**, please listen to the radio or call the Parish Office to check to see if Mass is cancelled for that evening. Father Chris will make a decision by Noon on those days.
- Whenever a county/city within the Diocese of Toledo is placed under a Level 3 Snow Emergency, the Catholic Churches will cancel Masses. Catholics in that region therefore, are dispensed from their obligation to attend.
- Catholics are encouraged to participate in Holy Mass via television, radio or internet making a spiritual Communion.
