





Flyers will posted with times and entry deadlines of each event, along with further details. So be on the lookout!


A word of caution, steel darts will not be allowed on the electronic boards, but electronic darts may be thrown on the steel boards.

We thought it was appropriate at this time to run a reprint of an article that appeared in our Fall 1995 DDA Newsletter:

SCHEDULING:

There have been a few questions from DDA members about how the scheduling is done. This is not something that is easily done or explained, but I'll give it a try. Rule of thumb is that the first place team of each division is moved up one division and the last place team is moved down one division. There are always extenuating circumstances, such as: teams changing members, one or more run away teams in a division, one or more teams way behind, new teams, teams dropping out, number of teams in a division, requests for a particular division, teams in a division finishing within a few points of each other and divisions changing. It's a fact that not everyone is always satisfied but there are a lot of issues to consider. The ultimate goal of the scheduling committee is to try to create parity within the divisions.
