Day 2: John 1:37-39

- 1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
- 2. Why do you think the disciples started following Jesus? Are you following him?
- 3. Spend time today thinking about how you can follow Jesus more closely in your day-to-day life.

Day 3: John 1:40-42

- 1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
- 2. What's the first thing Andrew does when he begins following Jesus?
- 3. Spend time today thinking about whom to invite to have a relationship with Jesus. How will you take steps toward this?

Day 4: John 1:43-46

- 1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
- 2. How do Philip's actions compare to Andrew's actions in v. 41?
- 3. Spend time today thinking about how God wants to use you in the lives of your friends.

Day 5: John 1:47-48

- 1. What word or phrase stands out to you from these verses? Why?
- 2. Do you think Jesus knows you the way he knows Nathanael? Why or why not?
- 3. Spend time today thinking about how well God knows you—and how that makes you feel.

Day 6: John 1:49-51

- 1. What word or phrase stands out to you from this passage? Why?
- 2. What causes Nathanael to believe Jesus is the Son of God? How does Jesus respond?
- 3. Spend time today thinking about what caused you to believe that Jesus is truly God's Son.

Day 7: John 1:35-51
