Southeastern Showdown Update 2019

The Southeastern Showdown has been designated as a NHSRA Western Legacy Series Rodeo. This means that the NHSRA will supplement each rodeo in the series with \$10,000. GHSRA will use this money (and add 1,000) to it as added money. \$1,000 will be added to each High School event. All of this money will be paid out to contestants. GHSRA will not retain or use any of the money.

The Georgia National Fairgrounds has increased stall cost by \$5.00. We are passing this increase on, but will be allowing you to come in on Thursday at no additional cost. Also, you may if you choose have shavings in your stall when you arrive. You may preorder them on the stall reservation form for \$7.00 per bale.

The Southeastern Showdown will also be a Junior American Qualifier in Barrels, Team Roping, Calf Roping, Breakaway and Steer Wrestling. You will enter on site before you run. You will qualify by NHSRA rules on the 2 runs total. You must be entered in the Southeastern Showdown to enter the Qualifier.

The Cinch Team Rodeo Varsity Cup will return with the same format as last year. Varsity Cup Team will be our Cinch Team.

A **Breakaway roping**, open to all **High School and Junior High School** contestants, **boys & girls** is being planned for **Friday at 2pm**. Tentative plans are for this to have \$1,000 added -- *details to follow*.

You must be a NHSRA member to compete in any of the Southeastern Showdown events or Qualifier.

The Georgia High School Rodeo Association would like to invite you to our annual Multi-State High School Rodeo. The location, as before will be at the GEORGIA FAIRGROUNDS & AGRICENTER in Perry, Georgia. This is a two go rodeo. The rodeo is in Reaves Arena which is an enclosed climate controlled building.

CALL – IN - Each state is in charge of their own call-in.

NC Call in will be **MONDAY, SEPT 30th from 8am-8pm**. Enter using the Rodeo Entry System on our website www.nchsrodeo.com. (This call-in is so early because GJHSRA has requested our entries be submitted at the first of October to give them plenty of time to plan and prepare.)

We will fill slots in performance before any slack will be available. Each State will have 2 holes available in each event for the performance times for each go round. There is 1 performance in each go. All other entries must be put in slack. Each State will have 10 holes for barrels and 10 holes for poles in the Saturday morning and Sunday morning slacks. All other entries for barrels and poles must be put in the Friday night and Saturday night slack. This could be adjusted based on number of entries.

Go round positions will be posted on www.ghsra.com by October 25th. The actual draw for placings in the rounds will not be posted. Both go rounds will be random draw.

ENTRY FEES – IF YOU ARE COMING AS A STATE - Fees for *timed events* will be \$35 per round (\$70 for both goes) and for *rough stock events* \$45 per round (\$90 for both goes). \$10 of each entry will be placed in a jackpot. Jackpot will be split and paid on each round. Awards will be given on the average.

****TWO WAYS to Pay your Fees:** (along with entry fees you need to include *Tshirt money*)

T-SHIRTS -

There will not be a vendor on site selling shirts. They will be preordered and there is a form at the end of this newsletter that you will need to fill out.

ORDER OF EVENTS – Bareback, Goat Tying, Saddle Bronc, Tie-Down Roping, Breakaway Roping, Steer Wrestling, Barrel Racing, Team Roping, Pole Bending and Bull Riding.

****Depending on the amount of entries in Bareback and Saddle Bronc these 2 events may be run at the same time with Goat Tying to follow. **There will be no slack in Bareback or Saddle Bronc**, Steer Wrestling slack will depend on the number of entries received and will run after Breakaway Roping in the slack. Bull Riding Slack will depend on the number of entries received. **If Bull Riding slack is needed it will be the first event in slack on Saturday and Sunday morning at 7am.****

CHURCH SERVICE – There will be a church service held on Sunday, **8:00 am** at the arena

GRAND ENTRY – We will have a grand entry at both performances. The themes for the grand entries will be posted on the GHSRA website. Please bring something appropriate for these grand entries. Sponsor Flags, Queens, and States will be presented at each Grand Entry. NO air horns are allowed in Reeves Arena.

SPECIAL GROUND RULES –

1. Thirty (30) second time limits will be in effect for all times events.
2. In all roping events, the one loop rule will be in effect.
3. Western attire is required for contestants at all times in Reeves Arena along with your back number.

AWARDS will be given to the average winners in each event and All Around Cowboy and All Around Cowgirl. Event winners will receive Gist Buckles and All Around Cowboy and Cowgirl will receive Gist Buckles and gift certificate for Corral Boots . Event reserve winners will receive Cinch Jeans gift certificates. In case of a tie for event champions, awards will be duplicated for winners and Reserve champion ties will be broken by a flip of a coin.

JACKPOT – Jackpot will be paid on each go. The money for the first go will be ready to pick up 1 hour after the 1st go is completed. The money for the second go will be ready to pick up within 30 minutes of the event completing. If you are not going to be present on Sunday afternoon we can mail your money to you or send it via your State designee.

ADMISSION – Contestants are free with back number. Advance weekend admission armbands can be purchased on the pre order form attached for \$15.00. Armbands purchased in advance will be available for pick up at the arena entry door from the barns during each performance. Children 12 and under admitted free. Admission at the door will be \$8.00 per day. Each State will receive 4 rodeo personnel passes. **Advance purchase must be received no later than Friday, November 1, 2019. You are in charge of getting this form to GHSRA by the deadline – These are NOT sent to NCHSRA.**

HORSE STALLS – There are over 600 covered horse stalls. Shavings are NOT provided. Shavings are for sale at the Fairgrounds and can be pre ordered on the attached stall order form. If shavings are pre ordered they will be in your stall when you arrive. The cost for preordered shavings from the Fairgrounds is \$7.00 a bag, or you may bring your own. EACH CONTESTANT MUST PUT THEIR HORSE OR HORSES IN A STALL WITH ONLY ONE HORSE PER STALL. NO HORSES CAN BE TIED TO TRAILERS AND NO PENS CAN BE SET UP AT TRAILERS. THIS IS AN AGRICENTER RULE.

The cost is \$55.00 per stall for the weekend in advance and needs to be pre ordered on the form attached. You are in charge of getting this form to GHSRA by the deadline – These are NOT sent to NCHSRA.

GHSRA will assign stalls according to the reservations and all States will be together if received in time. If you have a late stall request you may or may not be with your State or your other stalls. Stalls will be \$75.00 at the rodeo. Stall fees will not be refunded without a Vet or medical excuse. **Stall reservations must be received no later than Friday, October 25, 2019.**

RV HOOK-UPS – There is plenty of campsites with full hook-up. Arrange for any campsites directly with the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter to make your reservations. Your reservation can be made by calling 1-478-988-6557 or through their website, www.gnfa.com. No generators.

*****You will not be permitted admittance to the fairgrounds before 4:00 pm on Thursday, November 7th.**

The Agricenter has a security gate with personnel on duty 24 hours. In an emergency you can call 1-478-988-6557. They are there only for assistance and have no connections with the rodeo.

CHRISTMAS TOYS – Toys will again be collected, this year for the Perry Volunteer Outreach. Christmas will be right around the corner and we can make a difference to a child who would not perhaps otherwise have a present on Christmas morning. Toys will be collected and displayed at the arena entrance; if you can help it will be appreciated.

HORSE HEALTH PAPERS – Be sure you have a **NEGATIVE COGGINS** on your horse. Also, **HEALTH PAPERS** will be required when crossing state lines, to and from the rodeo.

DIRECTIONS TO RODEO – Take I-75 to exit 135, Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter, Perry, Georgia. Go east on Larry Walker Parkway, approximately 1 mile to the EAST GATE and proceed to the security gate.
