Aim: What happened in the beginning of the French Revolution?

## I. The Revolution Begins

- 1. May 1789, Louis calls the estates general, French Assembly
- 2. Not convened for 175 years
- 3. Third estate wants reform
- 4. Always outvoted 2:1
- 5. June 17<sup>th</sup> 1789 the National Assembly was created
- 6. Louis XVI locked them out of meeting hall
- 7. Make the Tennis Court Oath
- 8. Pledge to write a new constitution
- 9. July 14<sup>th</sup> 1789 Storming of Bastille

## II. National Assembly

- 1. 1789 sign the Declaration of the Rights of Man (similar to Dec. of Indep.)
- 2. Guarantees Liberty, fraternity, Equality
- 3. 1790 abolished taxes, church privileges, Church gov't control
- 4. 1791 Constitution: limited Monarchy, constitutional gov't
- 5. Louis XVI fled
- 6. 1793 Louis XVI executed for treason
- 7. National convention had three sides
- 8. Moderates, conservatives and radicals
- 9. Moderates wanted minor changes
- 10. Conservatives upheld the monarchy, wanted few changes
- 11. Radicals: opposed the monarchy, wanted many changes
- 12. National convention taken over by radicals

## III Reign of Terror

- 1. France becomes a republic in 1793
- 2. Led by radical group called Jacobins
- 3. Led by Maximilien Robespierre
- 4. Constitution thrown out
- 5. Committee of public safety had free reign to enforce terror
- 6. Led by Georges Danton
- 7. Beheaded over 40,000 people with the Guillotine
- 8. Killed all anti-revolutionaries
- 9. Danton: executed. Said "make sure to show my head to the people, its worth having a look at."
- 10. 1795 Robespierre was also executed the last death of the reign of terror
- 11. 1795 new constitution
- 12. Gov't went back to the public
- 13. Moderate control
- 14. Thermidorian reaction: created a 5 man Directory

"Terror is nothing other than justice; prompt, severe, inflexible" Robespierre
