

During the course of each year a particular question is brought forward. Does rank have its privelages? This may be asked at time of scheduling the league for weekly play or special events.

Most generally, the question pertains to the upper divisions and should they be accomidated when there are choices as to which pub/tavern a play-off or event will be held. Unfortuneately all pubs/taverns do not have the exact playing area. Some are quite exquisite and cater to the dart enthusiast while others offer the minimal of playing conditions.

The question raised to you is "should an upper division team, player or a complete division deserve to be put ahead of a lower division when these choices must be made?".

The Board of Directors has heard both sides of this argument. All players pay the same dues, an upper division player has better skills and deserves better playing conditions, upper divisions contain more "professional" players and need the better playing areas to sharpen their skills as they enter more major tournaments. These are but a few of the comments made.


