## A WARM WELCOME FOR ALL

Welcome to the Willette church of Christ, where you will find the Bible as our only rule for faith and practice. We seek to speak where the Bible speaks and to be silent where the Bible is silent. We want to call Bible things by Bible names and do Bible things in Bible ways.

Jesus said, "Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost" (Matthew 28:18-20). Our evangelistic efforts include several local and foreign mission works listed on the back of this bulletin. The home congregation is the most important work. Therefore, every month, we spend time door knocking, visiting, and helping our local community. We have a large benevolent building that operates every Tuesday from 8:30-12:30, which offers free clothes and other items to anyone in need. Our primary foreign work is found in Andhra Pradesh, India, where Brother *Jack Honeycutt* serves as our full time mission coordinator. We are also blessed to have a full time prison ministry with services conducted each Sunday from 1:00-3:00. Brother *Tim McHenry* is our regular preacher. In addition to preaching, he teaches classes and is involved in many works here at Willette. Our associate preachers *Mark West* and *Ben Smith* preach, teach classes, minister in the nursing home, coordinate our visitation teams, and work with our Bible camp and youth in general. In addition, we have a radio program on 102.1 FM that airs each weekday around 12:15.

We are a Bible centered, mission minded, and family oriented church. We hope you will enjoy our fellowship. Thank you for coming, and please return at every opportunity.

## *Tidings from Timothy*

People don't want to listen to the gospel. Certainly it is good news, but change is so uncomfortable that we cannot bear to hear it. The only way to get through to most people is to indoctrinate them when young to what is good and right. This is why the Bible Class teacher and any mentor for young people are so important. This morning we will look at aspects of an effective teacher and example. Tonight is singing night with finger food fellowship to follow.

**Sweetheart Banquet:** It has been many years since the church did one of these. We have some special activities to go with the meal, so we are looking for you to be there tonight! Everyone bring finger foods and old pics of you as a couple to be posted on the "guess who these are?" section. The evening will not take too long, but you don't want to miss who will be King and Queen of the banquet! We will also have a special time to honor our widows and widowers.

**This week:** The nursing home gets cranked back up with Services today at 2pm and on Wednesday we celebrate with those who have birthdays at 2pm.

**Sunday Seminar:** with Denny Petrillo will be March 10! It should be fascinating as we study on the subject of "How we got the Bible." I don't know that I have ever heard a series of lessons on this topic.

**Youth Events:** Tonight a group is going to Youth Unite at Center Grove. It starts at 5pm so transports will be leaving from the building at 4:10pm to get there. Don't forget that CYC will be the next weekend. What with all this going on we have a couple of announcements:

First: No Family Bible Hour tonight! We will resume next week.

Second: No Youth Devo after Next Sunday night. Our youth will most likely still have "car lag" from the CYC event.

Many people have tried to explain away Genesis 1-11 as mythology. In other words they say that it didn't really happen and is nothing more than a fairy tale. But let's see what the Bible says. In Matthew 19:4-6 Jesus quoted from Genesis 1 & 2 as being true. In John 8:44 Jesus called Satan the "father of lies" in referring back to Genesis 3:4. In Matthew 23:35 Jesus spoke of Abel in Genesis 4:2-10 as a real historical character. In Matthew 24:37-38 Jesus spoke of the Flood of Noah in Genesis 6-9 as a real historical event. If Genesis 1-11 is a myth then Jesus was mistaken in all of these cases.

In 1 Corinthians 11:8, 12 Paul states that man was first created, then woman just as Genesis 2:18-23 says. In 1 Timothy 2:13 Paul called Adam & Eve by name and in Romans 5:14 he says "death reigned from Adam to Moses." In 1 Corinthians 15:45 Paul says, "The first man Adam became a living being." But if Adam was only a mythological character then all of what Paul says is false. In 2 Corinthians 11:3 Paul says "But I fear, lest somehow, as the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness, so your minds may be corrupted." If Eve is a real character, and she is, I also fear today minds have been corrupted in believing that Genesis 1-11 is nothing but a fairy tale.

In Exodus 20:11 God told Moses, "For in six days the Lord made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them." Did God really only take 6 days for the creation as He refers to Genesis 1, or was He telling a lie? As Romans 3:4 says, "Let God be true, and every man a liar." Anything that differs from what God says is a lie. There are more than 100 references in the New Testament that refer back to the first eleven chapters of Genesis. If Satan can get people to believe that the first eleven chapters are a lie then how could we trust the rest of the Bible as it refers back to Genesis 1-11?
