## February ~ *Billy Black*

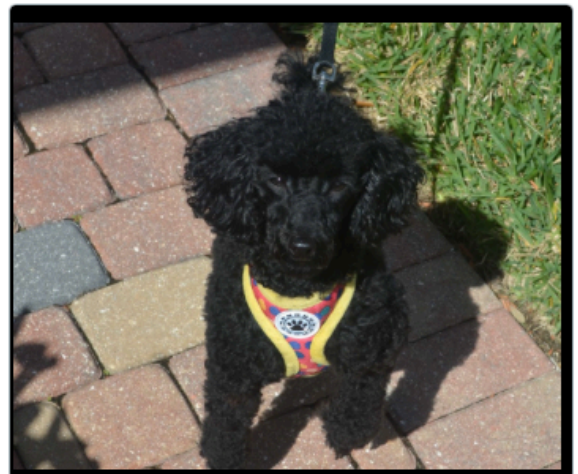
**Age:** 18 months
