

It's the time of year when we all enjoying pulling out our patriotic quilts! If you are looking to add to your quilt collection, we have several to choose from. We received Primitive Gatherings, American Gathering line and we have several kits made up from her new book.



We kitted Stately (uses mini charms), America Rolls On (uses jelly rolls), Charming American (uses charm packs), American Zig Zag (uses honey buns). If you want to venture and make a small table topper

using hexies, we have that kitted up as well. Lastly, we have Pioneer, which is a beautiful "snowball" block which uses her fat quarter bundles.



I have been working on a beautiful blue line from Marcus Fabrics by Red Crinoline Quilts called Bountiful Blues, using their pattern called Hanover Stars. It's an easy assembly using squares and flip and sew corners and having a

lovely block with no points to stress with. The quilt finishes 91x106 using a stunning border print.

These kits and more are in our shop and online. We hope you have a safe holiday!
