

ORDINANCE NO. 376

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE ACT OF PLACING SNOW, ICE OR OTHER MATERIAL ON THE STREET.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Snow or material of any kind may not be placed by any person on streets, avenues or city property except snow from sidewalks that are abutting streets or avenues without permission from the City of Rolla.

Section 2. No person shall deposit any snow or ice removed from any parking lot, filling station area, driveways, or from any other private property upon any public or city property or city street or sidewalk.

Section 3. Penalty

1. Upon conviction for violating this ordinance punishment shall be as follows:

- a. First Offense - a fine of up to \$50.00 plus the cost of removing snow, ice or material from area.
- b. Second Offense - within a twelve month period a fine of up to \$100.00 plus cost of removing snow, ice or material from area.
- c. Third offense and each subsequent offense within a twelve month period a fine of up to \$500.00 plus cost of removing snow, ice or material from area.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 5. Effective date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and take effect immediately upon final passage and publication of its title and penalty clause.
