2. Meeting led in prayer by Mr. Long.
3. Motion made by Mr. Blocker, seconded by Mr. Thompson and carried to accept minutes for the May meeting.
4. Motion made by Mr. Thompson, seconded by Mr. Blocker and carried to accept the resolution for the school bonds this is for the new school which will be under construction off of Highway 84. Mr. Long voted nay, and Mr. Gordon voted yea.
