A message from Fr. Brian Johnson regarding Sunday In-Person Mass:

Sunday In-Person mass continues with the same careful precautions. This statement last night from the Bishop's office, 11-19-2020, "Today the governor has proposed a voluntary suspension of public worship through December 13. Again, after consultation with my brother bishops, I am not at this time directing any suspension of public worship. We believe that the restrictions under which we have been operating (50% occupancy, facial covering, and physical distancing) have proven effective."

So, we at St Pius X & St Anthony parishes, will keep to the same careful precautions and good health practices: 1) under 50%seating capacity, 2) MASKS, 3) Proper Distancing, 4) no touch-contact, and 5) frequent use hand sanitizing. Again, be reminded that there is no Sunday Obligation currently still. And everyone with compromised immunity or pre-existing health risks, please keep safe at home. We are thankful to God for health and for our health care workers (pray for them!), and we want to protect one another. What we do for or not for, to the least of our brothers and sisters, we do to Christ!
