Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. (Matt. 6:9-10) We love the Lord, because He hears our voice and our supplications. It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray for you and your family (James 5:16), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). (Neh. 8:10) Mercy surrounds you and your house; be glad in the Lord and rejoice; and shout for joy, for mercy shall surround you and your family. (Ps. 32:10-11) Oh, send out Your light and Your truth, O Lord! May the Lord's light and His truth lead you and your family; let His light and His truth bring you and your loved ones to His holy hill and to His tabernacle. Then you and your people will go to the altar of God, to God your exceeding joy (Ps. 43:3-4); and make a joyful shout to God; sing out the honor of His name, and make His praise glorious (Ps. 66:1-2). According to the riches of His glory (Eph. 3:16) may God, who alone is wise (1 Tim. 1:17), give you and your family wisdom and knowledge and joy (Eccl. 2:26). May you and your house know the joy of His way (Job 8:19); He will fill your mouths with laughing, and your lips with rejoicing (Job 8:21). Those who hate you and your house will be clothed with shame, and the dwelling place of the wicked will come to nothing. (Job 8:22) The Lord shall delight in you and your family. He shall see your faces with joy, for He restores to you and your people His righteousness. (Job 33:26) The Lord desires truth in the inward parts, and in the hidden part He will make you and yours to know wisdom. He will purge you and your people with hyssop, and you shall be clean; He will wash you, and you shall be whiter than snow. He will make you and your people to

hear the joy and gladness and He will hide His face from your sins and blot out all your iniquities. He will create in you and your family clean hearts and renew a steadfast spirit within you. (Ps. 51:6-10) For the Lord who heals, Jehovah – Rapha (Ex. 15:26), restores your souls (Ps. 23:3). Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord **Jesus Christ** (Rom 15:6) from everlasting to everlasting! (1 Chr. 16:35-36)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the name of your Lord is a strong tower (Prov. 18:10); in His name let, you and your people put your trust. Let you and yours shout for joy because He defends you; in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your family will love His name and be joyful in Him. For the Lord will bless you and your house; with favor He will surround you and your family as with a shield. (Ps. 5:11-12) He will show you and your people the path of life; in His presence is fullness of joy; at His right hand are pleasures forevermore. (Ps. 16:11) You and your people shall have joy in His strength, and in His salvation how greatly shall you rejoice! (Ps. 21:1) According to His tender mercies (Ps. 119:156), may God grant to you and your family your heart's desire, and not withhold the request of your lips. May He meet you and your house with the blessing of goodness (Ps. 21:2-3), and give you and your people life and length of days forever and ever. Your glory is great in His salvation; honor and majesty He has placed upon you and your house. (Ps. 21:4-5) Your heads shall be lifted up above all your enemies all around you and your house. In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you and your family will offer sacrifices of joy in His tabernacle; and sing praises to the Lord (Ps. 27:6), that you and yours will do this willingly in the uprightness of your hearts (1 Chr. 29:17), raising your voice with resounding joy (1 Chr. 15:16). For you and your house will triumph in His praise! (1 Chr. 16:35) God has a mighty arm; strong is His hand, and high is His right hand. Righteousness and justice are the foundation of His throne; mercy and truth go before His face. Blessed are you and your family who know the joyful sound! May you and your people walk in the light of His countenance. In the name of the Lord may you and your house rejoice all the day long, and in His righteousness you and your house will be exalted. For He is the glory of your strength, and in His favor your horn is exalted. For your shield belongs to the Lord, and your King to the Holy One of Israel. (Ps. 89:13-18) For the Lord is there, the Lord is present, YHWH Shammah. (Ezek. 48:35) Yea, though you walk through the valley of the shadow of death, you will fear no evil; for He is with you and your house; His rod and

His staff shall comfort you and your family. (Ps. 23:4). Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever. (1 Chr. 16:34)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10), let you and your family shout joyfully to the Rock of your salvation. According to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), He gives you and yours eternal life, and you shall never perish; neither shall anyone snatch you out of His hand. His Father, who has given you to Him, is greater than all; and no one is able to snatch you out of His Father's hand. He and His Father are one. (John 10:28-30) May you and your family receive the glory, which **Jesus Christ** gives, that you may be one just as the Father and Son are One. (John 17:22) The Lord, YHWH - Yireh (the Lord will provide) (Gen. 22:14), is your shepherd, you shall not want (Ps. 23:1)! (Ezra. 6:22) In the name of **Jesus Christ**, through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Cor. 8:6), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your people serve the Lord with gladness and come before His presence with singing. Let you and yours know that the Lord, He is God, He is who made you, and not yourselves; you and your family are of His people and the sheep of His pasture. Let you and your people enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. May you and yours be thankful to Him, and bless His name. For the Lord is good, His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations. (Ps. 100:2-5) According to His excellent greatness (Ps. 150:2), the Lord grant you and your family to be multiplied and increased in your joy (Is. 9:3). Let your garments

always be white, and let your heads lack no oil. (Eccl. 9:8) May you and yours receive the word of knowledge through the Spirit. (1 Cor. 12:8) In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your family will have joy by the answer of your mouths, and a word spoken in due season, how good it is. (Prov. 15:23) May you and your people joy in doing justice (Prov. 21:15), and be counselors of peace (Prov. 12:20). The Lord is your Peace, Yahweh Shalom (Judge 6:24). He makes you lie down in green pastures; he leads you beside the still waters. (Ps. 23: 2). Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. (1 Chr. 29:11)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), abundance of grace and the gift of Righteousness will reign in life through the One, **Jesus Christ** (Rom. 5:17); in His name we pray you will live joyfully with your wife and family (Eccl. 9:9). Whatever your hands find to do, may you and your people do it with might. (Eccl. 9:10) According to the integrity (Ps. 78:72) of God's heart (Jer. 3:15), may God keep you and yours busy with the joy of your heart (Eccl. 5:20). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your people eat and drink and enjoy the good of all your labor for it is the gift of God. (Eccl. 3:12-13) Let you eat your bread with joy, and drink your wine with merry hearts; for God has accepted your works. (Eccl. 9:7) In the day of prosperity (Eccl. 7:14) the God of patience and comfort grant (Rom. 15:5) you and your house to be joyful. (Eccl. 7:14) Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servants, you and your family. (Ps. 35:27) In the day of adversity (Eccl. 7:14) in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray you and your house will not sorrow, for the joy of the Lord is your strength. (Neh. 8:10) For His anger is but for a moment, His favor is for life; weeping may endure for a night, but joy comes in the morning. (Ps. 30:5-5) For those who sow in tears shall reap in joy. (Ps. 126:5) Lord, by Your favor You have made our mountain stand strong. (Ps. 30:7). The Lord, YHWH - Yireh, will provide for you and your house (Gen. 22:14), you shall not want (Ps. 23:1). Both riches and honor come from You, O God, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all. Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name. (1 Chr. 29:12-13)

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), He Himself is your peace (Eph. 2:14), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that your souls shall be joyful in the Lord;

you and your people shall rejoice in His salvation (Ps. 35:9). May you and your family know the loving kindness of your God (Ps. 63:3), and your souls be satisfied as with marrow and fatness, and your mouths shall praise God with joyful lips. (Ps. 63:5) You and your people shall be clothed with righteousness (Ps. 132:9), salvation (Is. 61:10) and gladness (Ps. 30:11). For He made Him who knew no sin to be sin for you and yours, that you might become the righteousness of God in Him (2 Cor. 5:21), **Jesus the Christ** (Acts 9:34), the First and the Last, who was dead, and came to life (Rev. 2:8). The Lord your righteousness, YHWH Tsidkenu (Jer. 23:6), leads you in the paths of righteousness. For His names sake. (Ps. 23:3) The Lord reigns; the world also is firmly established, it shall not be moved. (Ps. 96:10) In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), your crown of glory (Is. 28:5), let you and your family be joyful in glory; let you and yours sing aloud on your bed. Let the high praises of God be in your mouths, and a two edged sword in your hands, to bind the kings of darkness with chains, and the nobles of darkness with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment this honor have all His saints. As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) we sanctify (1 John 17:17, 19, Heb. 13:12) you and your family, your time and your space, by the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14, 12:11). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), **Jesus Christ**, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed. The earth

is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein. (Ps. 24:1) The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him. (Col. 1:16) You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created. (Rev. 4:11) As a fellow worker in Christ, a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God. As a vessel of mercy, so that Christ might make known to you the riches of His glory, we claim you and all the people of the earth as the inheritance (Eph. 1:18) of our Lord Jesus Christ. By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom. (Dan. 7:22) Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and Christ will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin. And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now our salvation is near. (Rom. 13:11) Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it. (Is. 34:1)

We ask our Father in heaven in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), believing that you and your descendants receive all we ask for you (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14), petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you and your descendants according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you and your house (Luke 11:9) for it is written "Ask of Me, and I will give You the nations for Your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for Your possession." (Ps. 2:8). The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations. (Ps. 33:11) God is watching over His word to perform

it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (Is. 55:11). "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." Says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34) Let us join ourselves to the Lord, to serve Him, and to love the name of the Lord, to be His servants everyone who keeps from defiling the Sabbath, and holds fast to His Covenant (Is. 56:6), and He shall bring us to His holy mountain, and make us joyful in His house of prayer. (Is. 56:7) You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations. (Ps. 102:12) For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever. (Matt. 6:13) Amen
