Harry Potter Book Night is happening here at the library on February 3 from 5:00 – 6:30. Harry Potter Book Night was started in 2014. The theme for this book night is Magical Journeys. It has been 25 years since *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone* was released. It should be a fun night for Harry Potter fans with trivia, fun and food.

We are hosting **Bright Star Children's Touring Theatre** on February 27, 2022 at 3:00 p.m. at Giles Heritage Theatre for a **Black History Hall of Fame show**.
