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About the job: SENIOR PIPELINE SAFETY ENGINEER

This professional level position performs physical audits and inspections of pipeline Operators' facilities and operations to determine compliance with U.S. Department of Transportation and Indiana State pipeline safety regulations. The purpose of the Pipeline Safety Division and the Senior Pipeline Safety Engineer is to help ensure public safety through audits and inspections of those who deliver natural gas and hazardous liquids (Operators), and by educating Operators to help ensure compliance with Federal and State pipeline safety regulations.

This position reports to the Director of Pipeline Safety and performs the duties of the position under limited supervision. The position generally requires substantial knowledge of pipeline operations and Federal and State pipeline safety regulations. The incumbent must be self-motivated and organized and must possess excellent communication skills.

A day in the life:

Senior Pipeline Safety Engineers serve as front-line representatives of the IURC, primarily with pipeline operators, but also with contractors, consultants and at times the public. They are the first to identify possible violations of applicable pipeline safety regulations, and are therefore required to initiate compliance activities to bring about correction and compliance as swiftly as possible.

Senior Pipeline Safety Engineers are responsible for accurately reporting their activities and inspections results in order for the Division to receive credit when reporting to the DOT.

Duties of this position include:

- Scheduling and performing audits and inspections of pipeline Operators
- Documenting results of audits and inspections completed and communicating results to the Operators

Educating and training Operators regarding applicable Federal and State rules, regulations and initiatives coming from US DOT - Pipeline and Hazardous Materials Safety Administration (PHMSA).

- Must possess a bachelor's degree and 4 years' experience (minimum 10 years' experience without a degree) in gas or liquid pipelines or the enforcement of pipeline safety regulations at the Federal or State level.
 - Has received a completion certificate for all the applicable training at TQ or has received a waiver from PHMSA for applicable training not taken.
 - Maintains various Federal and State Pipeline Safety Certifications.
 - Other job requirements include:
 - Excellent attention to detail;
 - Solid verbal and written communication skills;
 - Understanding of basic IT concepts and working knowledge of Microsoft Office Suite;
 - Curiosity to learn;
 - Self-motivated;
 - Well organized;
 - Ability to deal with conflict and stressful situations and facilitate resolution/agreement
