A MOTION PASSED to adopt the agenda as presented (Motion – Elmer; 2nd – Handshoe; Unanimous)

EXECUTIVE SESSION

Hearings Before the Board of Directors (please note, board accommodated the hearing below even though quorum was not achieved until 6:18 p.m.)

Hearing: The hearing for T0701033 was called to order at 6:02 p.m. and the owner was present to discuss violation 1074 and an ACC application. The owner was thanked for their attendance and the hearing was adjourned at 6:20 p.m.

Hearing: The hearing for T0501029 was scheduled and confirmed. However, hours before the meeting the owner's lawyer called and asked for it to be rescheduled. Therefore, the hearing was not held.

Hearing: The hearing for T0801039 was called to order at 6:22 p.m. and the owners were present. The owners were thanked for their attendance and the hearing was adjourned at 6:37 p.m.

OPEN SESSION

Recap Decisions Made in Executive Session - The following decisions were made during executive session;

A MOTION PASSED to advise owner T0701033 that regarding the walkway (violation 1074); the requested variance was denied as it seems the improvement was done about one year ago. It will need to be removed, but the board is willing to grant 30 days to provide time to complete it. You are also welcome to resubmit for something that is within the guidelines. (Motion – Elmer; 2nd – Stephens; Unanimous).

A MOTION PASSED to advise owner T0701033 that regarding the patio cover; a decision was made to uphold the previous denial by the ACC committee (Motion – Handshoe; 2nd – Tice; Unanimous).

A MOTION PASSED to advise owner T0801039 that regarding the requested waiver of penalties, the Board denies the request as these fees have been paid by the Association (Motion – Tice; 2nd – Handshoe; Unanimous).

A MOTION PASSED to advise owner T0801039 that regarding the patio cover (violation 17); The patio cover cannot be approved as is. At such time that the shingles become in disrepair, you must replace the shingles that match the main dwelling roof. The flashing must be painted now to match the main dwelling color. Otherwise, the association won't pursue the patio cover. (Motion – Tice; 2nd – Handshoe; Unanimous)

Open Forum Discussions -Police Chief Provost with Fort Bend Sheriff's Department was present to discuss why the contract with Big Oaks MUD had to be cancelled August 1st.

A MOTION PASSED to denied the requested waiver of legal fees for T0202016 (Motion – Elmer; 2nd – Handshoe; Unanimous).

MOTION PASSED to disapprove the front patio for T0503003 (Motion - Handshoe; 2nd - Elmer; Unanimous).
