I gave this clip to throw the idea out there about screening and what can follow a screen. Again, this IS a foul....whether you have an illegal screen, a hold or a push.....get the foul. The biggest issue is that coaches are teaching this play. We MUST get it!

Take a look at a screen play [here](#). What do you have? Was contact made? Even if a screener is moving or set too wide or sticks out an elbow, if contact is not made there is no foul. That doesn't mean we ignore all screens by that player or team, it means we look HARD at their screens because we KNOW they will lean or stick an elbow or knee out and if contact is made, crack the whistle! They are the plays that prepare us for what a team plans to do!
