A Note from Rick: Markets steady at TLA this week. The Hay market Tuesday didn't have quite the top end as it has for the past few weeks, but was very steady from \$180/ton to \$280/ton. The calf market held in there for the 4th consecutive week of better prices. The feeder market will get a good test next week, but I don't anticipate any big changes as this market has been flat for quite some time now. The slaughter market was steady with mixed fats topping at \$114-\$117 and Holsteins from \$89-\$92. The better cows were \$48-\$55 while thinner cows were \$44-\$48. The Springer sale on Thursday was very similar price wise with the November sale. We didn't have quite as many as last month, but prices were nearly identical. The Dutch Cross Classic on Friday and Saturday was a great success. We had an awesome lineup of horses and a great crowd. Prices were better as well, with the horses averaging nearly \$600 per head more than last December. This sale has continued to improve sale after sale and we are very excited about where it will go in the future. Thank you to the consignors for giving us the opportunity to market these horses! We are looking forward to another great horse sale with the standardbred sale on the 27-28. Have a wonderful Advent season and we hope to see you at TLA!
