Red Sands Facts:

- Red Sands is a private, Christian School that is open to anyone. They operate with a statement of faith that all parents and students must agree to. The school prides itself on meeting, or exceeding, academic standards while basing it all on a strong Biblical value system.

Navajo Nation Facts:

- The Navajo Nation is a semi-autonomous Native American-governed territory covering over 27,000 square miles.
 It is the largest Native American reservation by land size in the U.S. It stretches among four states: New Mexico, Arizona, Utah, and Colorado.
- There are more than 300,000 enrolled members in Navajo Nation.
- Unemployment rate on the reservation is over 60%! Only 32% receive high school diploma's and less than 7% have a college degree.
- Although the Navajo Nation has a great deal of land, much of it is rural land without developed utilities. Thousands of people still live without power and running water on the reservation.
- Navajo originally lived in hogans, which are eight-sided buildings. They are cool in the summer, warm in the winter, and are typically still used for ceremonies. The hogan has a lot of significance to the Navajo, and even the door faces east to worship the sun as it rises.

Red Sands Christian School is a small school filled with big hearts! After visiting the school the fall of 2016, I knew One Day Closer Ministries wanted to help with the many needs of their students. Having the opportunity to meet the Navajo ladies, work with the teachers and children within the school, and discuss with school officials their amazing vision for the school, it was confirmed there are many areas of help needed.
