with developing a Natural Resources Inventory (NRI) for the Town, and
WHEREAS, an NRI contains information about a town's natural resources – groundwater,
streams, mineral resources, wetlands, farmland, habitats, plants, and wildlife – that can inform
land use planning and decision-making, climate resilience strategies, and serve as an education
tool, and
WHEREAS, the DEC Hudson River Estuary Program will provide guidance to create a basic
NRI incorporating information from prior Town plans and studies and coordinate with partners
to create a series of resource maps at no cost to the Town, and
WHEREAS, members of the CAC have committed to volunteer for the project and will be
responsible for public outreach, map review, and contributions to the NRI report,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED as follows:
That the Town Board of Union Vale does hereby agree to participate in the DEC Hudson River
Estuary Program technical assistance opportunity and authorizes the CAC on behalf of the
Town to work with DEC to create a Natural Resources Inventory.
