ORDER AMENDING ORDER RE:
PETITION NO. 2 ORDER GOVERNING
THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE
RECEIVER

(Assigned to Judge Teresa Sanders)

Peter S. Davis, the court appointed Receiver, having filed the *Motion to Amend Order Re: Petition No. Order Governing the Administration of the Receiver*, and the Court having considered same and it appearing to the Court that the matter being requested by the Motion are reasonable and appropriate:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED amending Paragraphs 3 and 6 of *Order Re: Petition No. 2* to read as follows:

1 3. Service List and Proof of Service. Service of all petitions and
2 other papers filed in connection with this receivership shall be governed by the
Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure and this paragraph:

3 a. Counsel for the Receiver shall maintain a Master Service
4 List containing the name and mailing address of each person, or the
person's legal counsel, who has made an appearance in this matter, or
5 has requested to be included on the Master Service List, or has been
placed there by order of the Court. All pleadings and other papers filed
6 in this matter shall be served as provided in this order on each person on
the Master Service List, except as provided in this order or by other
7 order of this Court.

8 b. Where the Court has provided for a separate mailing list
for a matter raised by petition, all pleadings and other papers filed in
9 connection with that petition shall be served on all persons on the special
service list for that petition.

10 c. The person filing a petition shall serve on all persons on
the applicable Service list, a copy of the petition and proposed form
11 order. If the petition is filed by the Receiver and involves the sale of an
asset of the receivership estate or the Receiver's final account and report,
12 the Receiver shall obtain a hearing date from the court and also serve a
notice of hearing.

13 d. Within five days (5) after the entry of an order granting or
14 denying relief under a petition, the person filing the petition shall serve a
conformed copy of the order entered by the Court on all persons on the
15 applicable service list.

16 e. All *ex parte* orders entered by the Court in accordance with
this Order shall be served by the Receiver on all persons on the Master
17 Service List within five (5) days after entry of the *ex parte* order.

18 f. Service under this paragraph shall be made as follows:

- 19 (1) by first class mail, postage prepaid, to the person at the
address set forth on the service list, or
20 (2) where the person has authorized service by email, by email
21 to the person at the email address set forth on the service
list.

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2 g. The party making service shall, within five (5) days after
3 making service, file and serve a proof of service, stating that a copy of
4 the petition or other paper was served on the persons set forth on the
5 attached applicable service list and the manner in which such service was
6 made.

7 h. Counsel for the Receiver shall provide a copy of the
8 Master Service List and any special service list to any person requesting
9 same.

10 i. Counsel for the Receiver shall remove the name of a
11 person from a service list upon receipt of a written request to do so from
12 the person or his counsel or when so directed by the court.

13 6. Notice Procedures. Notice of all proceedings in this receivership
14 shall be governed by the following provisions unless otherwise ordered by the
15 Court:

16 a. Notices of hearings set by the court regarding petitions for
17 authority to compensate the Receiver, attorneys and others, shall be
18 given by mailing a notice of the hearing to each person on the Master
19 Service List not later than seven (7) days before the date set for hearing.

20 b. Notice for hearing on petitions to approve the sale of assets
21 of the receivership estate or to approve the final account and report of
Receiver shall be given by mailing a notice of the hearing and a copy of
the petition to each person on the Master Service List not later than ten
(10) days before the date set for hearing, and the notice shall be
published once in the Arizona Business Gazette, or other newspaper of
general circulation, not later than seven (7) days before the date set for
hearing.

c. Unless otherwise ordered by the Court, all other matters
requiring the giving of public notice shall follow the procedure outlined
in subparagraph (a) above.
