I. Designer:

A qualified designer will be engaged for Design & Technology Development workshop of Handicrafts. Designer will develop the design prototype during the workshop, which will be further developed into marketable products by the handicrafts artisans.

(a) Objective

- Survey of artisans and crafts in the block level and also market study of handicrafts products.
- To develop 10 prototypes in each workshop.
- To make understand the methodology of prototype development and further production to the artisans.
- To document the entire process of workshop.

(b) Eligibility Criterion

- Designers should be empanelled with DC (H) or alumni of NIFT/NID, National Centre for Design & Product Development (NCDPD)
- The applicant should have at least **2 years of experience** of working as Designer, preferably in handicrafts sector and should have track record for promotion and development of the design and products in the handicrafts sector.

(c) Scope of Work

i. Survey/ Market Research:

- Survey of SC/ST artisans and their crafts at block level and submit survey reports with details of SC/ST artisans in a given format by Jharcraft Head Office.
- Local level market survey of handicrafts products and availability of raw materials at local market or at other location.
- 10 sketches with details specification of prototype for each workshop.
- List of raw materials & Equipments for workshop.

ii. Design & Technology Development Workshop

- Trained the artisans in methodology of product development and cost component of products.
- Training progress report has to be sent to Jharcraft, Head Office once in a week.
- Achievement cum performance report and Design documents has to be submitted to Jharcraft, Head Office.
- 2 set of 10 prototypes with specifications and cost sheet to be submitted to Design Studio, Jharcraft at the end of workshop.
- Soft Copy of design documents as per guideline of DC (H) has to be submitted to Jharcraft, Head Office.

(d) Duration of the Project

- Project duration is for one year. The designer will be engaged for three workshops in a year.
