Villages XI is a large group encampment with Council-wide participation. Similar to a Camporee, Villages will provide Brownie and Junior Girl Scouts (in membership year 2017-2018) the opportunity to tent camp in a park setting, gain new skills and practice familiar ones, have fun and make new friends with other Girls Scouts.

In addition to the Troop camping experience, beginning Friday afternoon and concluding Sunday, Villages participants experience a full day of Native American themed activities on Saturday. Each girl selects three Villages (or stations) of her personal interest and attends her Villages independent of other girls in her troop. In this way, participants not only have an influence on creating their own experience, but also meet new friends. Following a busy, fun-filled day, troops gather for an all-camp Campfire program Saturday night.

Villages XI will be held May 12-14, 2017 at Canyon RV Park. Cost is \$40.00 per girl and \$30.00 per adult. Girl cost includes site fee, t-shirt, patch and activities. Adult cost includes site fee, t-shirt, patch; and 2 mementos per troop. Canyon RV Park will be collecting a \$5.00 per car fee upon entrance. Program Aides (7th grade on up) may apply to help. Their cost is \$25.00, pending their application approval.

Girl Choices are:

Brownie Outdoor Cooking Village and Junior Outdoor Cooking Village: Come and learn to make yummy treats using various cooking methods in the out of doors. You won't want to miss this tasty workshop!

Coil Basket Weaving Village: Basket-making is something many different cultures in the world do! Join us to learn coil basket weaving - one of the essential items used in a Native American home.

Trek the Trail Village: Have you dreamed of going on a treasure hunt? Learn some of the skills used by explorers and detectives. Gain experience with using your very own compass (it will be provided) and prepare for a global adventure.

Surviving the Zombie Apocalypse Village: Learn to make fires without matches. Learn to make emergency shelters. Make and take corded Whistle holders and mini first aid kits.

Hummingbird Art and Science Village: In this age of space probes, personal drones, biotech, and self-driving cars, science is all around us. The hummingbird is the only warm-blooded earth species capable of flying and hovering naturally. We will look at the art and science of flight and hovering.

Brownie Adornments Village and Junior Adornments Village: Trinkets and rings, jangles and clings are all lovely things to wear and to share. Beautiful adornments are made in this Village. Let your creativity soar as you learn the basic techniques of jewelry making. Expert craft creators will guide you as you fashion wearable art!

The Art and Craft of Toys Village: What did the Native People's children play with? Certainly not some plastic toy made in a factory. Their amusement and their world of pretend came from everyday things around them and items from nature. Get creative; explore the art and craft of doll and toy making in this hands-on Village. Make and take some samples of your own.

Archery Village: (Juniors or older only): One little, two little, three little arrows A certified instructor of archery will teach you how to safely and effectively shoot arrows and hit the target!!

Art That Rocks Village: Come explore various methods of creating on art on rocks. Scrape at covering layers to expose the underlying surface like the Anasazi did to create petroglyphs that have survived for centuries. Other images on rocks are pictographs, made by applying color directly to surfaces to create those images. Using modern techniques, we will also make animal tokens in order to carry reminders of their spirit.

Beads & Things: Many American Indian tribes and cultures used beads and baubles as both decoration and a form of money. Learn to create designs using beads and a loom.
