All exhibits must be owned by and registered in the name of the exhibitor. To qualify for prize money, the exhibitor must show in one (1) line class and two (2) hitch classes. Each exhibitor will be paid \$80.00 per horse in hitch classes and \$40.00 per horse in line classes with a limit of six (6) horses per exhibitor. Should a shortage of horses occur, the Draft Horse Committee will decide whether to allow additional horses.
