

## Easter

"And when he (Herod) had apprehended him (Peter), he put him in prison, and delivered him to four quaternions of soldiers to keep him; intending after Easter to bring him forth to the people." Acts 12:4 (He wanted to celebrate Easter a pagan holiday to The queen of heaven, a festival of Astarte also called Ishtar pronounced "Easter." Herod wanted to first celebrate the Easter (Ishtar) festival before dealing with Peter. (Easter is translated from the Greek word pascha) Easter has never had anything to do with Jesus or Christianity, it Catholic paganism.

The word for Passover is translated from the Greek word **pecach** appears 28 times and is translated **Passover**, this referring to the Lord's Passover in Egypt sparing all the firstborn of Israel and killing all the first born in Egypt. (Exodus 12:12) In the book of Acts 12:4, the word Easter appears, (here the Greek word is **pascha**) here it relates to the pagan festival of the queen of heaven (**Ishtar**, **Astarte**).

The pagan festival of Easter was celebrated late in April and centered around reproduction. Symbols for the festival were the rabbit and the egg. **Astarte** also called **Ishtar** known as the queen of heaven (Jeremiah 7:18, 44:17-25) was the reason for the festival. She was the **mother of Tammuz** (Ezekiel

8:14) who was also **her husband!** These perverted rituals would take place at sunrise on Easter morning (Ezekiel 8:13-16).

Jewish Passover was held in mid April (14th) the pagan festival Easter was held later the same month. Passover was to be celebrated at evening (Deuteronomy 16:6) not at sunrise. Ezekiel 8:13-16 The Passover always precedes the feast of unleavened bread. The Passover Lamb is to be eaten on the night of April 14. On the morning of the 15 begins the days of unleavened bread.

"Then were the days of unleavened bread..." Acts 12:3 Peter was arrested during "the days of unleavened bread." (Acts 12:3)

"The children gather wood, and the fathers kindle the fire, and the women knead their dough, to make cakes to the queen of heaven, and to pour out drink offerings unto other gods, that they may provoke me to anger." (The queen of heaven Abomination.) Jeremiah 7:18
