Basic Latent Print Processing

Scope:

This class is designed to instruct forensic science practitioners and students in the area of Latent Print Processing through a hybrid format of online presentations, readings and written assignments, hands-on exercises, and a final exam.

Class:

This class is designed to introduce participants to this type of evidence and the various types of evidentiary items that impression evidence may be found upon, and the various development reagents that may be used to further enhance the contrast of the impressions. Through an introduction of the various types of surfaces (non-porous, porous, semi-porous, adhesive surfaces, and blood impressions) a variety of techniques will be discussed for the development of impressions. Students will further develop their understanding through the completion of written exercises, and a hands on assignment to understand how to work through each of the surfaces in a sequential method. This class is designed to allow participants to develop their knowledge of processing techniques and photographic capture methods for the preservation of evidence.

Participants will receive access to recorded lectures, all materials for the written assignments, and will be mailed a basic powder processing kit and supplies to complete the hands-on assignments.

Class benefits:

- The webinars included with the program have been approved by the IAI Latent Print Certification Board for 15 hours of continuing education credit towards certification and re-certification as the Latent Print Photography Series through Delta Forensics. An additional certificate of completion is issued for the program in its entirety.
