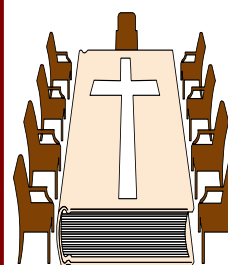


DIOCESAN LENTEN MISSION CONTINUES
