Colorado's own Senator Bennett originally saw Judge Gorsuch as extremely qualified, and yet chose not to vote for his confirmation. This from the man who calls himself “non- partisan”! 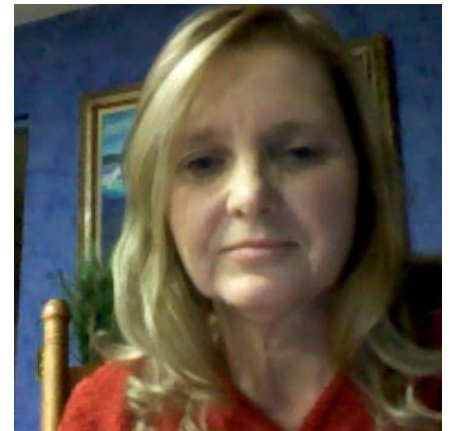
