NOTICE OF RACE

1 Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

In addition, the prescriptions of the Austrian Sailing Association as published on the ISAF web site will apply.

The Anti-Doping-Regulations of the Austrian Anti-Doping-Agency will apply.

The International Shark Class Association (ISCA) General Class Rules and Specifications will apply.

Racing rule 61.3 will be changed to allow for Arbitration, and a penalty less than disqualification for breaches of the rules of Part 2 and Rule 31. The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions.

Racing rule G3 will apply, allowing a loaned or chartered boat to carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of Shark class rules.

Racing rule(s) 46, 75.1, 78.1 will be changed as follows:

In addition to the requirements of RRS 75.1, a boat shall be entered by a full member in good standing of the International Shark Class Association, and that person shall be the "person in charge".



The Sailing Instructions may change other racing rules.

In addition:

Each boat shall carry at least three persons

The "person in charge" shall be identified at the time of registration

All crew shall be identified at the time of registration

Alternate crew but not the person in charge may be designated for specified days of the regatta provided all eligibility rules are met

Crew substitutions may be requested by submitting in writing the reasons for the substitution to the Regatta Headquarters for approval by the International Jury.

Decisions of the International Jury will be final, according to RRS 70.5.

If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

RRS Appendix P will apply.

2 Advertising

Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority, in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

Competitor advertising will be restricted as per the International Shark Class Rules.

3 Eligibility and Entry

The World Championship is open for all boats of the Shark24 class that are registered at an ISAF MNA (member national authority).

Each competitor shall be a member of his National Class Association and of his ISAF MNA.

4 Entry fee

The entry fee per boat is € 450,--

5 Registration

Check of Measurement certificate, liability insurance:

Thursday May 5, 2016 from 0900h to 2000h, and

Friday May 6, 2016 from 0800h to 1200h

at the Race office of the SCE

The sailing instructions will be available during registration.



6 Measurement and Equipment Inspection

Each boat shall produce a valid measurement certificate and shall be present for measurement checks.

Equipment inspections will be held:

Thursday, 5 May from 0900 to 1800

Friday, 6 May from 0900 to 1600

All boats are subject to spot checks at any other time.

7 Schedule

Friday, 6 May, 2016: 1400 practice race, 1800 Opening ceremony

Saturday, 7 May: first race 1000, Shark event 1900

Sunday, 8 May: Races

Monday, 9 May: Races, SCE event 1900

Tuesday, 10 May: Races, last starting signal 1300, prize giving ceremony appr. 2 hours after the last race

The total number of races is 10 (including a distance race) with a maximum of 3 races per day.

Freitag, 06.05.2016: 14 Uhr Practice Race, 18 Uhr Eröffnungszeremonie

Samstag, 07.05.2016: Erste Regatta 10 Uhr, Shark Event 19 Uhr

8 Courses and Racing Areas

The racing area is the southern part of lake Traunsee, The courses will be Up and Down with a target time of 50 minutes as provided in the Sailing Instructions. Separate course information for the long distance race will be posted at least at 20:00 hrs. on the day before it will take place on the official notice board or distributed sooner. The long distance race can be no earlier than the 5th race.

9 Scoring

4 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

When 5 or more races have been completed, a boat's score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.



10 Coach boats

Coach boats are permitted.

11 Berths

All boats, cars and trailers have to be put to the associated berths / places on shore.

12 Radio communication

A boat is not allowed to use radio communication. This also includes the use of mobile phones.

13 Prizes

Following prizes will be given:

The winner will be declared „2016 Shark24 Class World Champion“.

Prizes will be given to the top 5 boats in the final results.

The Metzger Trophy will be awarded to the boat with the best score counting the practice race, the distance race, and the final course race

Souvenir prizes will be given to all competitors.

14 Liability, pictures

Each competitor accepts to respect the RRS, good sportsmanship and all rules valid for the regatta. Each competitor participates on his own risk.

The organizers of the Regatta do not take any liability for damages or personal harm, to which reason ever except if gross negligence applies.

15 Media rights

Competitors grant the Organizing Authority an unrestricted right and permission in perpetuity to use the name and the image for any text, photograph or video footage of either themselves or the boat they are sailing during the event to be published or broadcast in any media whatsoever (including but not limited to Press and TV advertisements or Internet), for either editorial or advertising purposes or to be used in press information without any compensation to the competitor or the crew. In this respect, competitors and crew names and any biographical material of themselves may also be used or reproduced in any way known.

Segelclub Ebensee is granted the right to receive any compensation that is negotiated with any third party that wish to publish, broadcast or otherwise use such material. As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember can be required to sign a declaration. **Minors need the written permit of their legal guardians to participate in the regatta.**



16 Insurance

All participating boats need a valid third-party liability insurance with a cover of at least € 1.500.000,- or the equivalent. A copy of it shall be provided at the registration.

17 LOAN BOATS

A limited number of loaner boats will be made available to non-European entries on a first-come, first-served basis to crews from outside Europe for use at the regatta. Competitors are required to bring their own sails and any other racing equipment that they require. Participants requiring a loaner boat must indicate this when registering online.

Registrations forms from entrants requesting a loaner boat shall be received not later January 31st, 2016.

Competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the nautical qualities of their boat, the rigging, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the Shark24 World Championship, relieving of any responsibility the Organizing Authority, the Jury, the International Shark24 Association and all National Shark24 Associations and all persons involved in their organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behavior and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

In any case, competitors agree that the Segelclub Ebensee, the International Shark24 Association and all National Shark24 Associations, the sponsors of the Shark24 World Championship and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members, competitors or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Shark24 World Championship.

The Organizing Authority reminds the participants that there is commercial shipping traffic in the vicinity of the race area and the participants are expected to observe the IRPCAS in relation to all such vessels.

As part of the registration process, each individual participating crewmember can be required to sign a declaration accepting this disclaimer of liability.
