Marshfield Clinic (Multiple Programs)

FHC - Family Health Center-Marshfield Clinic

A federally funded program designed to provide preventive and primary health care to persons or families with limited income resources. Provides a variety of services for those who are eligible. Must have income less than 200%FPL. Benefits cover outpatient services (including outpatient surgery and medications) but not hospitalization. There is sometimes a waiting list. Monthly premium \$20 to \$70 based on income.

Provides various family planning services to Wisconsin women and men between the ages of 15 and 44 with income below 200% Federal Poverty Level. Services include: office visits for family planning services; limited lab services; tubal ligation and contraceptives; pap and pelvic exams, diagnosis, and certain follow-up services; STD screening, diagnosis and treatment; HIV screening, and transportation. Once on the program, services can be obtained at any clinic that accepts BadgerCare. However, both the Eau Claire Health Dept (open to Chippewa County residents) and Planned Parenthood not only can sign people up but also provide services on the same day.
