3. Demonstrated performance in completing animal care related duties, as well as or better than expected level of performance in the facility.
4. Demonstrates pursuit of knowledge and education concerning laboratory animal welfare and care.
5. Supervisory responsibilities and formal degrees are not required for nomination to this award.
6. Be a member in good standing of the Three Rivers Branch of AALAS.
7. Nominated by any TRBAALAS member in good standing.
