## Ordinance Number 44

SNOW DUMPING ORDINANCE

An ordinance enacted to provide for the public peace and health and for safety of the public and property within the Township, which prohibits depositing or placing snow on land of another; provides for the issuance of permits to deposit or place snow or ice on land of another: requires clean-up of debris left from dumping snow or ice; and provides for penalties for violation thereof.

## THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF IRONWOOD ORDAINES:

SECTION 1. No person shall dump, deposit, place, store, unload or otherwise cause to be placed or deposited in or upon the land of another any snow or ice without obtaining a permit in accordance with

SECTION 2: The Township Clerk may Issue permits to persons desiring to perform any act specified in Section 1 of this Ordinance: PROVIDED said persons pay such fee as established by the Township Board; obtain the written permission of the owner of the land to be used: and fully comply with the requirements of Section 3 of this Ordinance

SECTION 3: Upon the melting of any snow or ice deposited or placed on the land of another, the person, who deposited or placed the said snow or ice, shall remove any garbage, debris, trash, or other items brought on to the property by the deposit or placement of snow or ice and shall dispose of same in a lawful manner.

SECTION 4: The Township Supervisor shall provide written notice, via first class mail, to any person violating Section 3 of this Ordinance. Said notice shall allow a person thirty (30) days in which to comply with Section 3 of this Ordinance. If a violation persists, the Township Supervisor may cause such property to be cleaned at the expense of the violator and the costs incurred by the Township in so doing shall be solely the responsibility of the violator and be in addition to other penalties provided by this Ordinance or law.

SECTION 5: Any person who shall violate any provision of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by up to 90 days in jail and/or a fine of up to \$500. Each day a violation persists shall be deemed a separate offense.

SECTION 6: This Ordinance shall be effective upon its adoption and publication, as required by law. ADOPTED AND APPROVED by the Charter Township of Ironwood, this 28th day of March 2000.

CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF IRONWOOD ORDINANCE #449 - Amends ordinancett AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO UNNECESSARY NOISES, DEFINING THE SAME, AND PROHIBITING ALL UNNECESSARY NOISE IN THE TOWNSHIP OF IRONWOOD, GOGEBIC COUNTY, MICHIGAN, AND PROVIDING PENAL TIES FOR THE MAKING THEREOF AND FOR VIOLATIONSS OF THIS ORDINANCE. THE TOWNSHIP OF IRONWOOD HEREBY AMENDS ORDINANCE #1 AS FOLLOWS:

Section 4 shall be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 4. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable as follows: Upon conviction of any offense for violation of the above Ordinance, by fine of not more than \$500 and/or by imprisonment of not more than 90 days in the county jail. In addition, any person convicted shall be responsible for all attorney fees and costs incurred by Township in enforcing the provisions of this Ordinance as to the person's particular violation for upon which he/she was convicted.

2. All other provisions of Ordinance #1 shall remain in full force and effect.

This amended ordinance shall take effect upon its adoption and publication in accordance with Michigan law. This amendment to Ordinance #1 was duly adopted by the Charter Township of ironwood Board on the 28th day of March 2000 at a special meeting thereof. The Ordinance with this amendment shall continue to be known as Ordinance #1, "An ordinance relating to unnecessary noises, defining the same, and prohibiting all unnecessary noise in the Township of Ironwood, Gogebic County, Michigan, and providing penalties for the making thereof and for violations of this ordinance", of the Charter Township of Ironwood.
