Shabbat Chazon

August 9 - 10, 2019 / 9 Av

Guidelines for Shabbat Chazon & Motzei Tisha B'Av

- If you know you will be in Shul when Shabbat ends, bring non-leather shoes for Tisha B'Av to Shul before Shabbat.
- You can still make early Shabbat and eat meat and drink wine at the Shabbat meal.
- Regular Torah learning is allowed the entire Shabbat.
- You can eat meat and drink wine as usual throughout the entire Shabbat.
- There is no Seuda Mafseket this year, **but all eating must conclude by 8:01pm.**
- After 8:47pm, "Baruch Hamavdil Bein Kodesh L'chol" is recited, shoes are removed and only a fire is used for Havdallah. At the conclusion of Tisha B'Av, Havdallah is recited on wine or beer.
- All restrictions for the Nine Days conclude at the end of Tisha B'Av, except for eating meat and drinking wine (with the exception of wine for Havdallah), which can resume on Monday morning.

On Tisha B'Av afternoon at 5:45pm, we will screen "Who Will Write Our History." In November 1940, days after the Nazis sealed 450,000 Jews in the Warsaw Ghetto, a secret band of journalists, scholars and community leaders decided to fight back. Led by historian Emanuel Ringelblum, and known by the code name Oyneg Shabes, this clandestine group vowed to defeat Nazi lies and propaganda, not with guns or fists but with pen and paper. Their story is told for the first time in this 1 hour, 35 minute documentary, featuring the writings of the Oyneg Shabes archive, with new interviews, rarely- seen footage, and stunning dramatizations.
