

Dump Cakes are a great dessert for a crowd. They're quick, easy, and foolproof. Use any combination of canned pie filling and boxed cake mix that you think will appeal to your guests. Scoop out servings with a spoon and top them with ice cream or whipped cream. Yum!

Dump Cake

Yield: 8-10 generous servings

Prep time: 5-10 minutes

Cook time: 50 minutes

1 can (21 oz.) fruit pie filling

1 can (20 oz.) crushed pineapple (don't drain)

Optional: 1 C. chopped nuts or shredded coconut

1 box (18.25 oz.) dry cake mix

1 ½ sticks butter, cut into 12 tablespoons

Whipped cream or ice cream topping

1. Dump fruit pie filling and crushed pineapple into a *greased* 9x13 cake pan or casserole dish. Mix with a wooden spoon. Optional: Top with 1 C. chopped nuts or shredded coconut.
2. Sprinkle dry cake mix on top of fruit. DO NOT mix or blend.
3. Lay tablespoons of sliced butter over the dry cake mix.
4. Bake cake in a 350-degree oven for 50-55 minutes, until top is brown and fruit is bubbling.
5. Serve a scoop of cake with a dollop of whipped cream or ice cream. Enjoy warm!
