## Sea Cadet Corps Medal

**BEFORE** starting on your SAR Sea Cadet Corps Medal Form below, please follow the “Save” instructions.

Use the “Save to Your PC” button. Add the Cadet’s Name to the Saved file Name.

For example, “**Cadet PO2 George Compatriot Sea Cadet Corps Medal.PDF**”.

*When you place your mouse over most of the “text” data entry fields below, a feature called a “tooltip” will display as a window/popup to give you additional instructions concerning what should be entered in that field.*

**“Tooltips” provide important instructions – Please read them carefully.**

Recipients are selected for a high degree of merit with respect to leadership qualities, military bearing and general excellence. The recipients are selected by the Commanding Officer of the Sea Cadet Unit, who should be given full latitude in making the selection. The criteria for receiving this award is set forth in the NSCC Regulations:

- a. Attained the rate of Petty Officer Second Class or above and is in good standing militarily and scholastically at the time of selection and presentation.
- b. The cadet nominated must demonstrate a high degree of merit with respect to leadership qualities, military bearing, and excellence in the performance of duties; have the potential for greater leadership responsibilities; and be recommended by the unit Commanding Officer.
- c. The recipient of the award will be selected and nominated to the local SAR Chapter President, who will normally make the award.

The medal is bronze, struck on a circular planchet and on the obverse is depicted a Minuteman holding a rifle, with a plow and the Liberty Bell in the background. It is inscribed, with the letters, "Good Citizenship Medal". The reverse is inscribed "Our inspiration is from the past, our duty is in the present, our hope is in the future." It is suspended from a ribbon of the SAR colors. A certificate of recognition accompanies the medal. It is recommended that the Sea Cadet Medal Ribbon Bar be presented along with the Bronze Good Citizenship Medal.

No NSCC Cadet recipient may receive the Medal more than once.

One medal will normally be awarded each year in each NSCC unit.

The SAR Committee Chairman should complete as much of this form as possible before emailing it as an “attachment” to their NSCC Commanding Officers.
