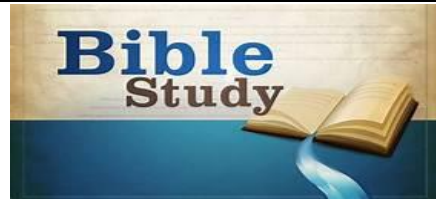

Tickets may be purchased in person at the St Mark parish office or can be purchased at the door.

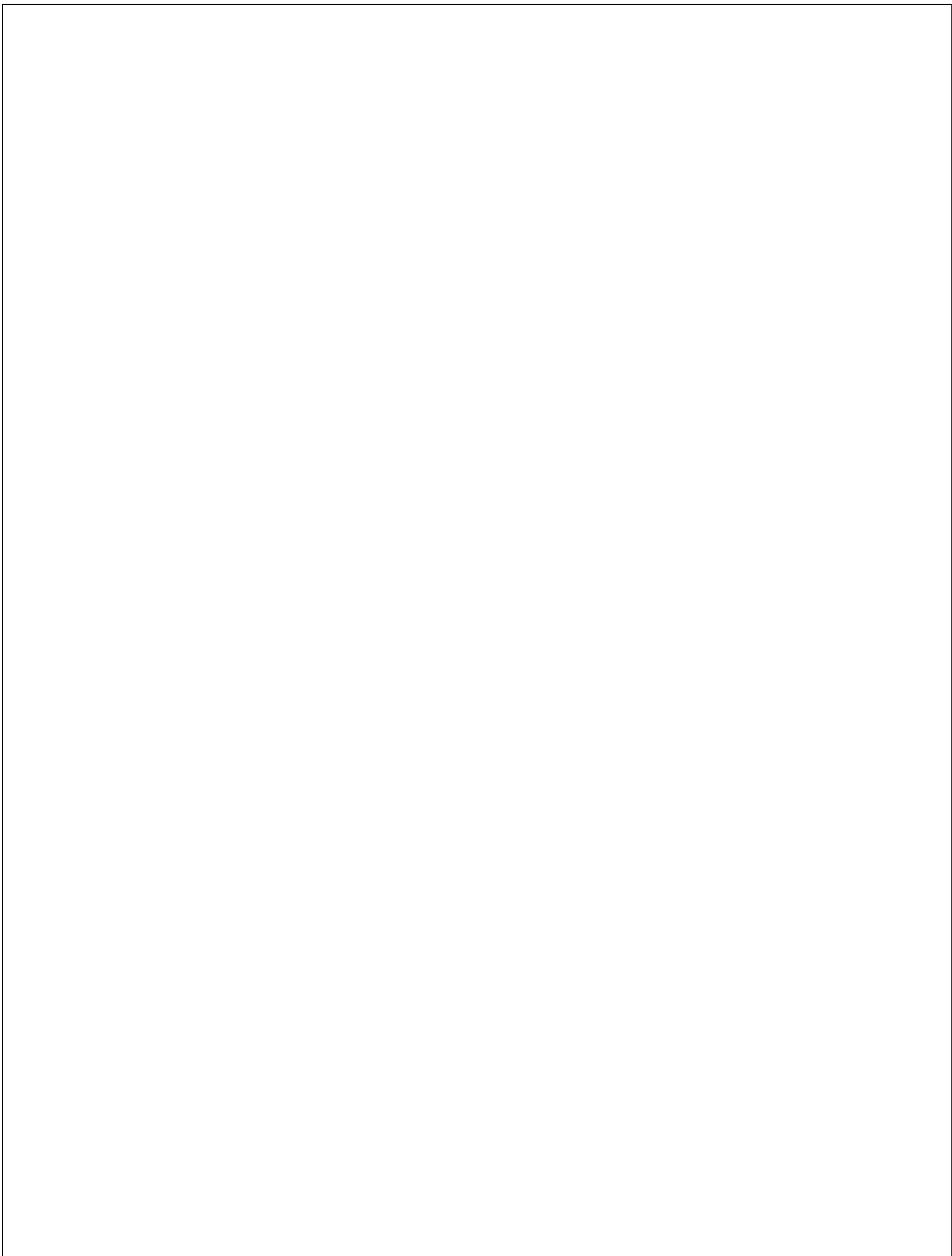
