

ORDINANCE NO. 273

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 10 OF ORDINANCE NO. 188 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 233, INCREASING THE SERVICE CHARGES FOR COLLECTION OF GARBAGE AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROLLA, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. That Section 10 of Ordinance No. 188 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 10(a). Amount of Service Charges. The head of each family, or proprietor or occupant of each dwelling or residential premises, served by or using the garbage disposal facilities in any manner whatsoever, shall pay a charge for the use of the garbage disposal system and for the services which may be rendered and performed in and about the collection, removal and disposal of garbage, of \$ 4.00 per month for the first kitchen and \$ 1.50 per month for each additional kitchen on said premises; Each business establishment shall pay a minimum charge of \$ 12.00 or up to a maximum charge of \$ 100.00 per month as set by the Garbage Committee of the City Council, based on increased services rendered; the Council shall finally determine the charges by approving or changing those set by the Committee.

Section 10(b). Collection of Service Charges. Garbage disposal charges provided for herein shall be added to the charges for water and sewer services, and collected on the same bills, which are billed monthly. The amount of garbage disposal charges shall be stated as a separate amount, however, and shall be kept in a separate accounting fund to be known as the Garbage Disposal Fund. In all cases where water or sewer service is not available to property, and garbage disposal service is used by the property owners, agent or tenant of such real estate, the charge for said service shall be billed by the Water Department separately and shall be due and payable at the same time that the bills for the water service and garbage disposal as above set forth are due and payable. The City may shut off water service for delinquency in payment of any City utility service, whether water, sewer, garbage or otherwise, or may in the alternative sue for collection or add to the taxes of property served in the same manner as are sidewalk assessments."

Section 2. Effective date. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect and take effect immediately upon its final passage and approval.
