Finance Report:


Trustees reviewed and audited bank reconciliation, payment listing, receipt detail, fund status, and revenue status reports

Old Business:

- 1) Minutes from the June 19, 2017 regular monthly meeting were read and approved. Motion to approve Grant Minnich, Second Ben Sutter, motion carried 3-0.
- 2) Resurfacing of south bridge on Stetler Road was discussed.
 - a. Duane Counterman to call Mercer County Engineer

New Business:

- 1) Curtis Hamrick informed trustees that the township received the MORE grant from OTARMA in the amount of \$500 to be used for safety equipment.
- 2) Curtis Hamrick informed trustees that the township received a refund from the Ohio Bureau of Workers Compensation in the amount of \$520 from the 2015 premium.
 - a. Money is supposed to be used for safety and wellness.
- 3) Trustees discussed increasing the amount allocated for maintenance of road equipment for 2018.
- 4) Trustees approved reallocating \$500 from 1000-110-314-0000 (tax collection fees) to 1000-110-370-000 (payment to another political subdivision) to cover the deduction for Mercer County Health Department on second half real estate taxes. Motion to accept reallocation Duane Counterman. Seconded by Grant Minnich. Motion carried 3-0.
- 5) Mercer county engineer is planning starting chip and seal project August 21.
- 6) Trustees reviewed township responsibility of controlling noxious weeds.
 - a. Ohio law includes road right of ways, residential properties, and line fences separating properties.
- 7) Grant Minnich shared that minor storm damage occurred in the township.
 - a. Inspection of roads revealed 2 signs were down; they were reported to Mercer County Sherriff.
- 8) Discussion was held responsibility of the township to control medical marijuana dispensaries.
- 9) Resolution 4-2017 prohibiting medical marijuana dispensaries in Blackcreek Township was passed by the trustees by a 3-0 vote.
- 10) Curtis Hamrick reminded trustees that the zoning board will meet August 21 at 8:00 p.m.
- 11) Motion to Adjourn was made by Ben Sutter. Seconded by Duane Counterman. Motion carried 3-0.
