Legislative News - These bills in congress have been introduced to the committee and could come out for a vote:

- HR 1186 Is Keep American Safe Act . This would limit High- Capacity Magazine's
- HR 1236 Extreme Risk Protection Order Act
- HR 2708 Disarm Hate Act

Each of these have some real question for gun owners. You find them by going to @ us Congress Bills to read about them. 1236 & 2708 Have real concern of due process of the law. We could lose some of our second amendments rights. So call your Congress men or women express your concerns.

Clearance Forms - Pa Act (2014) requires all adult club volunteers to complete and submit Pa background checks, when working with unaccompanied minors (under the age of 18). This applies to all club activities. Many members have already submitted these forms, and a list, with expiration dates, is posted in the clubhouse. Please do not assume we have all of them, or that we have all of the expiration dates correct. We are collecting new forms. Please check your copies, and renew if you need to. Sergeant Christopher M. Wrinkle is a 2001 Yorktown Area High School graduate. Following graduation, he served as a Special Operations Multi-Purpose K9 Handler for the 1st Marine Special Operations Battalion, 1st Marine Special Operations Company, 4 and 4th Marine Special Operations Team 421 in Herat Province in Afghanistan.

He was deployed to Afghanistan on July 1, 2011, and passed away while trying to rescue his beloved service dog and partner, Tosca, from a bunker fire later that month on July 31. We are forever grateful for Sgt. Wrinkle's loyalty and courage. Today's ceremony ensures that his courageous legacy is never forgotten.

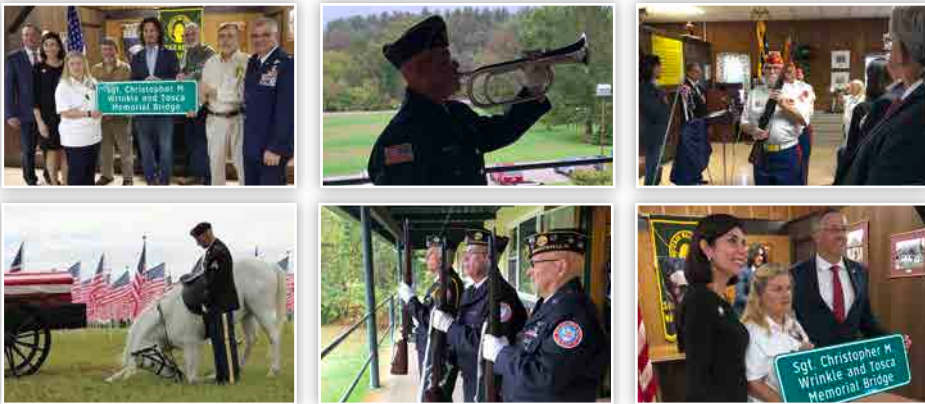
