COMMUNICATION IS KEY: We do our best to communicate with our Parents about special events and dates. PLEASE make sure you check the mailboxes, e-mails, messages on the check in station, outside board, and papers we post on the doors and near the check in station to stay informed.

PARKING LOT SAFETY: We all are very busy and in a hurry to get to places on time. Although we may be in a hurry, it is important to follow all the signs in the parking lot to ensure every child and parent enters and exits safely. Please enter ONLY through the entrance and exit ONLY through the exit to avoid any potential accidents. Also please do not park in the underpass unless it is raining as this may cause traffic and confusion during dropoffs and pick-ups. Our goal is to ensure the safety of all students and members on our property. If you have any questions or concerns, please speak with a member of the admin staff.

READING IS FUNDAMENTAL: No matter what age your child may be, reading is fundamental to your child's development. By reading a minimum of 15 minutes a day to your child, you can increase their cognitive skills, literacy skills, interest in reading, and even gain a stronger bond with your child.

UNITY DAY: Every month the school recognizes a different country in the world and is introduced to their culture and customs. This month the country we are recognizing is Haiti. If you would like a specific country to be recognized or would like to bring us in food or come in and speak about the country, please feel free and speak with Ms. Liz or Ms. Mya.

REVIEWING POLICIES:

- •PAYMENTS: Tuition is due on the Monday of the week the children will be attending.
- •LATE PAYMENTS: Any accounts with a balance on Monday at noon will be subject to our late payment fee of \$30, as stated on the Parent Handbook.
- <u>VACATION</u>: If your child will be on Vacation for an entire week we will charge a \$40 spot hold fee in place of your Tuition Rate as a courtesy.
- •WITHDRAWAL: A two week written notice is required for all children enrolled in a full-time, part-time, Preschool, or VPK only program. Please note that if you chose to leave without giving us the 2 week notice you will still be in charge of paying the tuition for those 2 weeks.

MONTHLY EVENTS:

PARENT LUNCHEON- This is a day where parents are invited to come in and eat lunch with their child and socialize with other parents at the school. The parent luncheon will usually be held on the 3rd Thursday of each month from 11am-11:30am (depends on your child's scheduled lunch time). Parents are welcomed and encouraged to attend. The parent luncheon for August will be on Thursday, August 22nd.

MAIL DAY MONDAYS: Every other Monday is mail day. On this day, you can bring us a letter from you to your child and the "mailman" will have it delivered to their classrooms. Your child's teacher will read them his/her letter during a special "love filled circle time". You can also have your child write letters to some of their favorite friends!

Tuesdays with TUMBLING BUGS: Tumbling Bugs brings gymnastics classes right to our preschool! Every Friday they come to our center and transform a classroom or a spot in the playground into a gymnastics obstacle course. Their fun filled lessons incorporate music, games and are led by a qualified and dedicated instructor. The cost is \$40/month. Please see the office to sign up your child.

WEDNESDAYS Bible Study: Every Wednesday each class has Bible Study for approximately 15-20 minutes to teach the children a mini lesson from the bible.

VPK MISSION CLUBS- For 3 Tuesdays out of the month, VPK students are given the opportunity to work in a variety of different ways to help contribute to their society. There are 3 different clubs: Cards, Letters, and Keepsakes Club (\$1/month), Music and Bible Club (\$1/month), and Garden & Workshop Club (\$1/month). They utilize special skills and utilize their different learning forms to help make the world a better place. All proceeds that we receive from the Mission Clubs will go towards nonprofit organizations such as The Leukemia Foundation and March of Dimes.
