

**What's Your Blueprint for Leading?**

When you say the word leader; what face or name comes to mind?

An entrepreneur or CEO

Do you think of yourself as a leader? You are! You may not lead a business, a church, a team or a military unit, but you are still called to lead.

- A husband becomes a leader when he says, "I Do."
