Hello Church! Have you ever felt like being a Christian is a list of to-do's and to-don'ts? Have you ever wondered if there is more to faith than that? Have you ever felt like something was missing? Recipe of the Month

BEST EVER CHEESEBALL

(This was Orpha's recipe)

- 3-8 oz. Philadelphia Cream Cheese
- 1 - 5 oz. Jar Kraft Old English Cheese Spread
- 1-5 oz. Jar Kraft Pimento Cheese Spread
- 1-4.5 oz. Jar Armour dried chipped beef (diced up)
- 6-green onions (chopped up)

Let cream cheese soften, add the 2 cheese spreads and mix well. Add the chopped up dried beef and chopped green onions and mix well. Chill in fridge for a while & then roll ball in chopped nuts and parsley flakes. If you don't want nuts, just roll in parsley flakes. This will make a very large ball, you may want to divide it into 2 balls.
