

Lake, Ocean & River Fishing:

Connor Sabo Fishing Reports for June 29, 2017 at 2:23pm

With the closure of the Skeena River it has left the Terrace area very quiet when normally we are flooded with locals and tourists trying to get a nice Chinook. It has left us to find something else to pass the time until July 15th when the Skeena Opens back up so that means either traveling to the Kitimat River which is not affected from this closure or out to the ocean!

I got a few hours on the weekend and decided to try my luck in Chatham sound out of Port Edward. The original plan was to travel to Humpback Bay in search of Spring salmon in the morning but weather was on and off and only having a small boat I need to be careful out there and watch that I don't get caught in the big waves that can some times come out of no where.

I decided to stay close in between Kinahan and Rachel islands and found a nice area with some good structure and dropped the anchor within an hour we had the Halibut around. After releasing a few smaller fish I brought up a 110cm Halibut the limit being 133cm I was pretty happy. Over all it was a really great day and I can't wait to get out again!

The heavy rain caused the lack of pictures!
