At the end of March we once again were the hosts of three Interstate Judges for the 2021 EAC Animal Care SA State Championships. We are now in the process of organising Interstate Judges for our HOTY event in November which will come around before we know it.

The next two months will be CUR days, followed by a short break in August when the grounds are usually too wet. We will be back in September for the annual Charity Competition. We will have the usual colour parade with prizes for Juniors and Seniors. We are in the final stages for organising this year's Charity and will announce it and the theme colours ASAP.

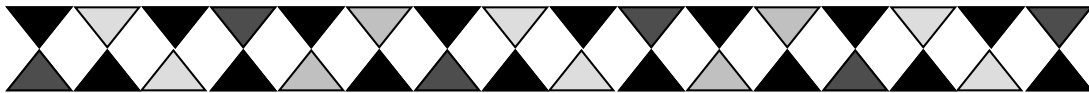
October is also a CUR day but with a difference, as this will be a Fun / Come and Try Day with different forms of dressage tests – pairs, Prix Caprilli, Pony Club and in-hand, as well as some regular classes. Copies of the relevant tests will be available on our website in the coming months.



In April we ran the Judges' Jackpot competition, an initiative of the Dressage SA Committee. This is held to encourage and enable Judges to qualify or upgrade, with cash prizes on offer for competitive riders. It proved to be a popular concept with a good number of entries and it was certainly encouraging to see some of our younger riders step up to take on the role of being Judges. A very positive boost for the future of our Sport.

Our Training days continue to be very popular. The April Training Day was with coach Denise Rofe. Denise instructed in horse and rider biomechanics, with the addition of some drill work. We also had a few people new to our Training Days enter, which was great to see. We are organising instructors for the next few months and so far have Anne Smith in June and Lucy Williams in July.

We had two competition in May. The 8th was another Championship event, this time the Club Championships, sponsored by Horseland Mount Barker and on the 22nd, a much smaller CUR day. We had perfect weather, enjoyed by all who took part.

This can also be done in person at the office or via a text message to the number provided on the draw. **Failure to do so in future may incur elimination.**

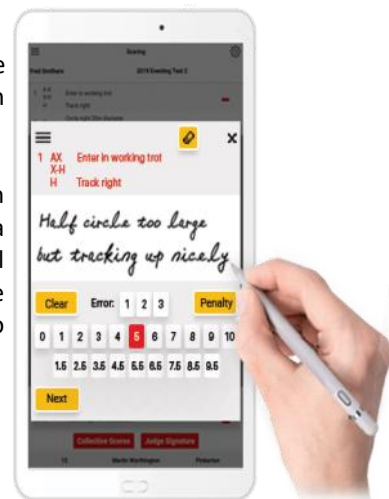


Tech Boost For Sporting Clubs

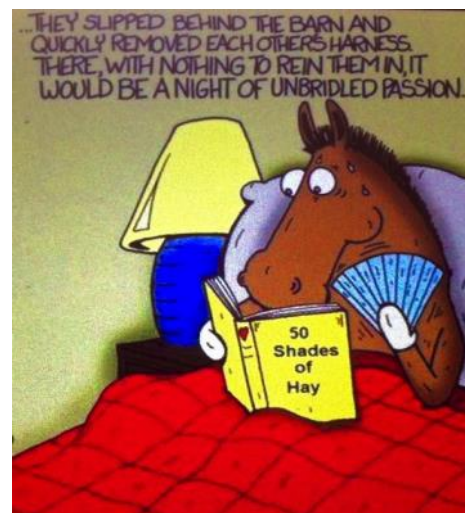

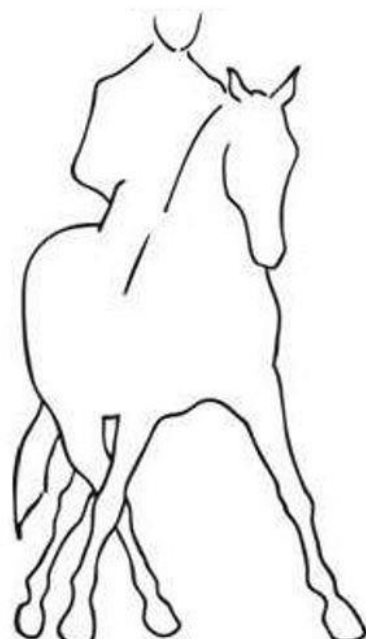
