Team report

Over the last 5 weeks, the Kings Runners have participated in 6 Invitationals with some impressive results.

For the ladies, the highlight was a victory, ousting 40 other teams, at the Tiffin Carnival Varsity B race. Leading the team, and finishing second overall was Leah Maschino in 19:30. The Lady Knights had 4 runners in the top 11. The guys finished 5th out of 43 teams. The JV boys also won big in their race scoring a solid first place finish out of 42 teams with 6 guys in the top 16 spots.

The following week, the ladies finished 2nd and the gentlemen 6th at a rain soaked Eaton Invitational. The guys were led by a personal best time from sophomore Gideon Diebel.

At the Centerville Saturday Night Lights, despite another wet course, 13 Lady Knights set season best times, including Leah Maschino with a team best 18:46.

On Sept 29, the Kings Invitational was held at rainy Landen Park with both varsity teams taking second, with the ladies only missing 1st by 1 point to Turpin. Chris Stock set a boys team season best time at 17:06.

Another rainy Saturday, another Invitational at Kettering produced the closest race of the year, when the Varsity boys finished third to Elder and LaSalle, with just 3 points separating 1st from third. Isaac Onnen led the team with a PR of 17:11. The JV Boys finished 1st in their race with 5 boys in the top 20 finishers overall, showing the strength and depth of the boys team.

It was a great weather day for racing at this past Saturday's Ross CC Invitational! The boys finished 3rd out of 11 teams with PR's set by many. Gideon Diebel and Chris Stock set amazing best times of 16:40 and 16:47 respectively. The girls finished 2nd behind Turpin. Leah Maschino, Hannah Rasmussen, and Jennifer Cooper set personal bests with times of 18:36, 19:08, and 19:33 to finish in the top 10 overall in the race.

<u>The ECC Championship meet is this Saturday at Valley View in Milford!</u> Based off recent results, the top two teams for the ladies are Turpin and Kings. Kings has 5 of the top 10 runners, based off personal records. For the boys, Anderson is the team to beat, but as Kings continues to improve each week, it would be no surprise to see the Knights take the Championship.
