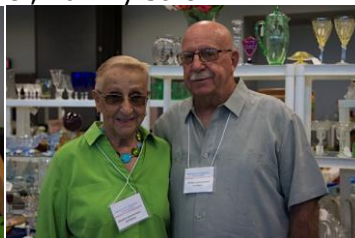
Message about Kent from Vicki Hale and Carole Martinez:
