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### **Purpose:**

This section shall provide guidelines for special events which shall include, but not limited to, field trips, state or national competitions, delegates' meetings, or city events.

All special events require the approval of fire administration prior to the event.

### **Non-City Special Event Procedures:**

- a) Travel arrangements and documentation shall be completed by the cadet advisor and/or his associate advisors.
- b) Participation in such events is a privilege to be earned by participation in weekly meetings, attendance, special events worked, attitude and disciplinary issues. It shall be the decision of the unit advisors as to which members shall attend.
- c) Upon arrival at the destination, room assignments, curfews, and other information will be given by an advisor or designee.
- d) No member shall leave the event site without direct permission from an advisor.
- e) All members must conduct themselves in a professional manner and shall abide by all program by-laws, Boy Scouts of America rules and hosting agency's rules.
- f) Any time members of the opposite sex are present in a room together, the hall door and/or curtains shall remain open.
- g) No member, regardless of age, shall possess, use, or consume any alcoholic beverage.
- h) No member, regardless of age, shall be permitted to use any type of tobacco, illegal drugs or alcohol.
