RESIDENTS INVITED TO ATTEND THE FIRST GENERAL PLAN COMMUNITY WORKSHOP

(DIAMOND BAR, CA, October 12, 2016) – This past fall, the City of Diamond Bar started the important, multi-year process of updating its General Plan that will create a community vision and blueprint for growth and development in the city through 2040.

Specifically, the General Plan will address land use, all modes of transportation, economic development, parks and open space, housing, environmental sustainability, safety and public services.

Residents are encouraged to attend the first community workshop of the General Plan Update process, taking place on Wednesday, November 9 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. at the Diamond Bar Center, located at 1600 Grand Avenue.

The objective of this workshop is for City staff and consultants to:

- share information about the purpose and function of a General Plan;
- provide a progress reports outlining tasks, both completed and upcoming; and
- give attendees a chance to share their ideas and priorities in relation to future land-use planning activities.
