

**Prov 20:1** Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging: and whosoever is deceived thereby is not wise.

**Gen 9:21** And he drank of the wine, and was drunken; and he was uncovered within his tent.

**Prov 20:2** The fear of a king is as the roaring of a lion: whoso provoketh him to anger sinneth against his own soul.

**Ps 78:40** How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, and grieve him in the desert!

**Heb 3:16** For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

**Deut 1:35** Surely there shall not one of these men of this evil generation see that good land, which I sware to give unto your fathers,

**Deut 1:36** Save Caleb the son of Jephunneh; he shall see it, and to him will I give the land that he hath trodden upon, and to his children, because he hath wholly followed the LORD.

**Deut 1:38** But Joshua the son of Nun, which standeth before thee, he shall go in thither: encourage him: for he shall cause Israel to inherit it.

**Ps 95:10** Forty years long was I grieved with this generation, and said, It is a people that do err in their heart, and they have not known my ways:

**Acts 7:36** He brought them out, after that he had shewed wonders and signs in the land of Egypt, and in the Red sea, and in the wilderness forty years.

**Exod 12:41** And it came to pass at the end of the four hundred and thirty years, even the selfsame day it came to pass, that all the hosts of the LORD went out from the land of Egypt.

**Exod 3:8** And I am come down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians, and to bring them up out of that land unto a good land and a large, unto a land flowing with milk and honey;

**Exod 6:6** Wherefore say unto the children of Israel, I am the LORD, and I will bring you out from under the burdens of the Egyptians, and I will rid you out of their bondage, and I will redeem you with a stretched out arm, and with great judgments:

**Ps 136:11** And brought out Israel from among them: for his mercy endureth for ever:

**Exod 12:51** And it came to pass the selfsame day, that the LORD did bring the children of Israel out of the land of Egypt by their armies.

**Exod 13:3** And Moses said unto the people, Remember this day, in which ye came out from Egypt, out of the house of bondage; for by strength of hand the LORD brought you out from this place: there shall no leavened bread be eaten.

**Exod 7:4** But Pharaoh shall not hearken unto you, that I may lay my hand upon Egypt, and bring forth mine armies, and my people the children of Israel, out of the land of Egypt by great judgments.

**Exod 33:1** And the LORD said unto Moses, Depart, and go up hence, thou and the people which thou hast brought up out of the land of Egypt, unto the land which I sware unto Abraham, to Isaac, and to Jacob, saying, Unto thy seed will I give it:[Ex.12:]7

**Deut 6:21** Then thou shalt say unto thy son, We were Pharaoh's bondmen in Egypt; and the LORD brought us out of Egypt with a mighty hand:

**Deut 6:23** And he brought us out from thence, that he might bring us in, to give us the land which he sware unto our fathers.

**Acts 13:18** And about the time of forty years suffered he their manners in the wilderness.

**Prov 20:3** It is an honour for a man to cease from strife: but every fool will be meddling.

**Prov 20:4** The sluggard will not plow by reason of the cold; therefore shall he beg in harvest, and have nothing.

**Prov 10:4** He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich.

**Prov 19:15** Slothfulness casteth into a deep sleep; and an idle soul shall suffer hunger.

**Prov 20:5** Counsel in the heart of man is like deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out.

**Prov 20:6** Most men will proclaim every one his own goodness: but a faithful man who can find?

**Prov 20:7** The just man walketh in his integrity: his children are blessed after him.

**Prov 20:8** A king that sitteth in the throne of judgment scattereth away all evil with his eyes.

**Prov 20:9** Who can say, I have made my heart clean, I am pure from my sin?

**Ps 130:3** If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?

**Nah 1:6** Who can stand before his indignation? and who can abide in the fierceness of his anger? His fury is poured out like fire, and the rocks are thrown down by him.

**1Kgs 8:46** If they sin against thee, (for there is no man that sinneth not,) and thou be angry with them, and deliver them to the enemy, so that they carry them away captives unto the land of the enemy, far or near;

**Jer 10:10** But the LORD is the true God, he is the living God, and an everlasting king: at his wrath the earth shall tremble, and the nations shall not be able to abide his indignation.

**Ps 29:10** The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever.

**Mal 3:2** But who may abide the day of his coming? and who shall stand when he appeareth? for He is like a refiner's fire, and like fullers' soap:

**Prov 20:10** Divers weights, and divers measures, both of them are alike abomination to the LORD.

**Prov 20:11** Even a child is known by his doings, whether his work be pure, and whether it be right.

**Matt 7:16** **Ye shall know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes of thorns, or figs of thistles?**

**Matt 7:18** **A good tree cannot bring forth evil fruit, neither can a corrupt tree bring forth good fruit.**

**Prov 20:12** The hearing ear, and the seeing eye, the LORD hath made even both of them.

**Prov 20:13** Love not sleep, lest thou come to poverty; open thine eyes, and thou shalt be satisfied with bread.

**Rom 12:11** Not slothful in business; fervent in spirit; serving the Lord;

**Prov 20:14** It is naught, it is naught, saith the buyer: but when he is gone his way, then he boasteth.

**Prov 20:15** There is gold, and a multitude of rubies: but the lips of knowledge are a precious jewel.

**Prov 20:16** Take his garment that is surety for a stranger: and take a pledge of him for a strange woman.

**Prov 22:26** Be not thou one of them that strike hands, or of them that are sureties for debts.

**Prov 11:15** He that is surety for a stranger shall smart for it: and he that hateth suretiship is sure

**Prov 20:17** Bread of deceit is sweet to a man; but afterwards his mouth shall be filled with gravel.

**Prov 9:17** Stolen waters are sweet, and bread eaten in secret is pleasant.

**Prov 20:18** Every purpose is established by counsel: and with good advice make war.

**Prov 20:19** He that goeth about as a talebearer revealeth secrets: therefore meddle not with him that flattereth with his lips.

**Prov 20:20** Whoso curseth his father or his mother, his lamp shall be put out in obscure darkness.

**Prov 20:21** An inheritance may be gotten hastily at the beginning; but the end thereof shall not be blessed.

**Prov 28:20** A faithful man shall abound with blessings: but he that maketh haste to be rich shall not be innocent.

**Hab 2:6** Shall not all these take up a parable against him, and a taunting proverb against him, and say, Woe to him that increaseth that which is not his! How long? and to him that ladeth himself with thick clay!

**Prov 13:11** Wealth gotten by vanity shall be diminished: but he that gathereth by labour shall increase

**Prov 23:4** Labour not to be rich: cease from thine own wisdom.

**1Tim 6:9** But they that will be rich fall into temptation and a snare, and into many foolish and hurtful lusts, which drown men in destruction and perdition.

**Prov 20:22** Say not thou, I will recompense evil; but wait on the LORD, and he shall save thee.

**Prov 20:23** Divers weights are an abomination unto the LORD; and a false balance is not good.

**Prov 20:24** Man's goings are of the LORD; how can a man then understand his own way?

**Prov 20:25** It is a snare to the man who devoureth that which is holy, and after vows to make enquiry.

**Prov 20:26** A wise king scattereth the wicked, and bringeth the wheel over them.

**Prov 20:27** The spirit of man is the candle of the LORD, searching all the inward parts of the belly.

**Prov 20:28** Mercy and truth preserve the king: and his throne is upholden by mercy.

**Prov 20:29** The glory of young men is their strength: and the beauty of old men is the gray head.

**Prov 16:31** The hoary head is a crown of glory, if it be found in the way of righteousness.

**Prov 20:30** The blueness of a wound cleanseth away evil: so do stripes the inward parts of the belly.
